

Linda, a native Maori of New Zealand moved to the United States with her husband and four children, in June of 1981.

Te Manawa Maori of Southern California began in 1990. As Director, Linda has taught the songs and dances of the Maori for the past 25 years. The focus has been to show the most authentic of Maoritanga outside of New Zealand. They have danced in Utah, California, Arizona, Minnesota, Las Vegas, Chicago and New York. In April of 2001, some of the members were privileged to return to New Zealand and dance at the Maori Arts and Crafts Institute, the Plaza Hotel in Rotorua, and also, in Whangarei, Hamilton



and Raglan. The group has performed for many film premiers and events for Air New Zealand, Pacific Islander festivals and the New Zealand Consulate.

Linda and her daughter Kellie have traveled to many parts of the United States giving lectures at colleges, elementary and high schools, and for churches and civic groups. She retired in August of 2009 after almost 20 years in construction management with an international Japanese Construction Company.

Linda has been privileged to teach Maori to many, many, groups and still continues to do so. Her most cherished acknowledgement is the sweetness of being called 'Aunty Linda' by all whom she has taught.
